You wish to travel to Italy for university studies (University Admission)

- Original long-stay visa application form, completed and signed**
Download the form, although it will also be provided to you upon arrival at the VFS Global center
- Biometric photograph**
Recent color identity photo (width 35 mm, height 40 mm), taken within the last 6 months, on a white background with uncovered face, compliant with [ICAO](#) standards
- Original passport**
With a validity exceeding the requested visa by at least 15 months and containing at least two blank facing pages for the visa
- Photocopy of the passport**
Photocopy of the biometric data page and all pages containing visas as well as entry and exit stamps from the Schengen area, including a photocopy of the previous passport if the current passport is less than one year old.
- Reservation**
- Declaration of availability of accommodation in Italy**

- Completed and signed certificate of pre-enrollment in the course in Italy submitted exclusively through the [UniversItaly portal](#).**
- Photocopy of documents relating to previous studies**
- Proof of financial means of subsistence (those of the parents for a minor)**
According to the parameters defined by the Italian Ministry of Education (at least 848,32 € for each month of the academic year), this proof may be demonstrated with:
 - a. Proof of personal or family financial means (bank statements for the last six months). No financial guarantee presented by third parties will be accepted.*
 - b. Financial guarantees provided by recognized Italian institutions or by foreign authorities considered reliable by the competent Italian diplomatic representation.*
- Certificate of proficiency in the language in which the course will be taught (minimum level B2)**
- Family certificate indicating the father, mother and possibly brothers and sisters**
- Supporting documents regarding the socio-professional status of the parents and, where applicable, of the guarantors, to be submitted together with a document establishing the family relationship.**
Photocopy.

Medical insurance covering treatment and/or possible hospitalization

- 1. Consular declaration certifying that the applicant benefits from the right to medical services under the partnership between the applicant's country and Italy*
- 2. Foreign insurance policy or policy subscribed with an Italian organization that must not include limitations or exceptions regarding costs established for emergency hospitalization*

The Embassy reserves the right to request additional documents in support of the application.
