

LIST OF DOCUMENTS
FOR FAMILY REUNIFICATION VISA WITH A NON-EU CITIZEN

You are going to Italy to join a non-EU citizen already settled in Italy in order to maintain family unity.

- Original long-stay visa application form, completed and signed**
Download the form, although it will also be provided to you upon arrival at the VFS Global center
- Biometric photograph**
Recent color identity photo (width 35 mm, height 40 mm), taken within the last 6 months, on a white background with uncovered face, compliant with [ICAO](#) standards.
- Original passport**
With a validity exceeding the requested visa by at least 15 months and containing at least two blank facing pages for the visa
- Photocopy of the passport**
Photocopy of the biometric data page and all pages containing visas as well as entry and exit stamps from the Schengen area, including a photocopy of the previous passport if the current passport is less than one year old.
- Copy of the authorization (Nulla Osta) issued by the competent Sportello Unico per l'Immigrazione**
- Original family certificate**
Legalized by the Daïra and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria
- Italian translation of the family certificate**
Legalized by the consular section of the Italian Embassy

furthermore, and exclusively for parents or parents-in-law:

- Documentation proving that the applicant is in a state of economic dependency**
- Documentation proving the regular and periodic transfer of money to dependent parents residing in Algeria**
- Birth certificate of the son/daughter residing in Italy (original)**
Legalized by the Daïra and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria.
- Italian translation of the birth certificate of the son/daughter residing in Italy**
Legalized by the consular section of the Italian Embassy
- If the applicant has other children: socio-professional documentation for each child residing in Algeria or abroad**
 - if they reside abroad: certified copy by the local authority of the country of residence of their residence permit.

- if they are in Algeria: socio-professional documentation.
- if children are in a state of health involving total disability, medical certificate issued by a doctor approved by the Embassy, certifying the impossibility of permanently providing for daily living needs.

furthermore, exclusively in the case of minor children:

Consent declaration from the parent remaining in Algeria

Declaration of consent for the minor's departure and family reunification in Italy, signed by the non-applying parent and legalized by the Daira and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria.

Copy of the identity document of the parent giving consent

In the event of sole custody, death, or any other particular circumstance: official documentation proving the family situation
